CABA TO PARTICIPATE IN HIGH PERFORMANCE BUILDING COUNCIL

October 22, 2009

The Continental Automated Buildings Association has teamed with the Sustainable Buildings Industry Council and other organizations to participate on the National Institute of Building Sciences' High Performance Building Council.

The goal of the Council is to put standards in place to define the performance goals of a high performance building in order to facilitate the design, construction, financing, and operation of buildings with an emphasis on life cycle issues rather than initial costs.

The Council is charged to do this work as stipulated in Section 914 of the 2005 U.S. Energy Policy Act, and is specifically tasked with identifying the metrics and level of required performance for specific design objectives, such as: energy, security, durability, moisture, and acoustics, for building products, subsystems and systems; and reference industry standards for validating these performance requirements.
